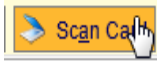

Frequently Asked Questions

What types of scanners are available?

There are two types: Both scanners come with Optical Character Recognition (OCR) software.

1. Camera Card Scanner: **SnapShell R2® Scanner** It takes a picture of the card. The card must then be manually flipped to take a picture of the other side.

2. **Duplex Card Scanner:** Scanshell® 800DXN is a high-speed A6 duplex ID card scanner which offers simultaneous high image quality capture of both sides of the scanned card.

- Weight: 17 oz.
- Resolution: 600 dpi (dots per inch)

What can be imported?

Driver's License: First and Last Name, Middle Initial, Address, Gender, Driver's License Number, Date of Birth and Photo. (The photo can be used as the patient picture in other areas of PDSMDSUITE, e.g. Room View.)

Insurance Card: Policy Number, Group Number, and Copay

Which company provides these scanners?

We have worked closely with CSSN - Card Scanning Solutions - to integrate these scanners into PDSMDSUITE. For more information about CSSN go to: <http://card-reader.com/>

Which driver's license and insurance cards can be scanned?

CSSN OCR software can read driver's licenses from all 50 states. The medical insurance OCR library is logic based and does require you to update templates.

Are there any additional fees after I purchase the scanner and software?

CSSN templates and OCR software are automatically updated regularly. This function requires PDSMDSUITE Support and is a nominal fee per year.

What is the accuracy rate?

Both scanners are rated at 98-99%. Accuracy will vary based upon the quality of the card being scanned. It is always a good policy to proof-read the scanner's results.

I already have a card scanner. Will it work?

If you have the same scanners as described in this Product Sheet, then you would only need to purchase the OCR software license. However, if you have different scanners then they will not work.

Can I still use the scanner if I am connecting to PDSMDSUITE via Remote Desktop or Citrix?

Yes, however, you will need to purchase one copy of IPscan per workstation connecting via these methods. IPscan is software permitting the scanner to be installed on your workstation and PDSMDSUITE to be installed on another workstation (the one being connected).
